About Our Client:

Riverway JCU Football Club is a community-driven football club in Townsville, Northern Queensland, with two locations. To support the club's growth, Precision Sports Lighting was contracted to upgrade the lighting at Charles Moroney Park in Kelso, the primary clubhouse.

Kelso, located about 20 km southwest of Townsville's CBD, is a growing suburb known for its community spirit and family-friendly environment. The new lighting enhances safety, boosts participation, and improves the experience for players, families, and spectators while fostering community connection and inclusion.



Sports Lighting Project Overview:

The project was completed after Riverway JCU Football Club received funding from the Queensland Government's Play Our Way Program Grant, supported by Football Queensland's Women's Legacy Fund.

This funding focused on enhancing facilities to promote participation, particularly among women and girls, and ensuring long-term community benefits.

The club aimed to improve security, safety, and communication with the addition of sports lighting, security lighting, CCTV, and a public address system.

A cohesive design approach ensured seamless integration of these systems without disrupting club operations or community access.

Scope of Works:

- Lighting designed to Semi-Professional Level of Play standards for high-quality illumination.
- Installation of 16 x LED sports luminaires for energy-efficient lighting.
- 4 x galvanized, base-hinged steel poles for durability and maintenance.
- Security lighting to enhance visibility and safety.
- CCTV installation for improved security monitoring.
- New public address system for better communication during events.
